This year's theme is "Powered by Connection." This theme recognizes the profound impact that meaningful relationships and social connections have on our health and wellbeing. Connectedness plays a vital role in supporting independence and aging in place by combatting isolation, loneliness and other issues.

Older Americans Month was initiated in 1963. At that time, only 17 million Americans were 65+. One third of those were living below the Federal poverty level. Those under poverty level are now approximately 10%. The fact that Americans continue employment after 65 years of age has also increased. Surely, this contributes to this change.

Currently Americans 65+ number approximately 62 million and that number is expected to increase by 30 million over the next 10 years. Older adults represent a tremendous presence in today's families, communities, and churches. Watch the newsletter for continued articles on this subject.

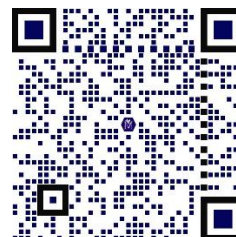
