Free tax preparation and filing programs begin Feb. 3 in New Hanover County

NEW HANOVER COUNTY, NC – Starting February 3, residents can receive free tax preparation and filing by trained, IRS-certified volunteers through the Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) and AARP Tax-Aide programs.

These programs will be available at no cost through April 15 for all New Hanover County residents, regardless of age. Some days and locations require appointments, while others are first-come, first-serve.

“This will be our 47th year providing free tax preparation services in New Hanover County,” said Senior Resource Center Director Amber Smith. “Thanks to the amazing dedication of our trained and certified volunteers, we will be offering two services, at no cost, to our residents who need help filing their taxes for 2024. Last year, we served more than 3,000 residents through these programs, and we are glad to be able to offer this again.”

Tax preparation will be available at the following locations:

NHC Senior Resource Center: 2222 South College Road, Wilmington

- Days of operation:
 - Monday - Friday (9 a.m.-11 a.m.): Drop off tax preparation by appointment only.
 - Saturday, March 1st, 8th, 15th, 22nd, and 29th (9 a.m.-11 a.m.): In-person tax preparation and no appointments are needed (first-come, first-served) (limited availability).
- Clients are required to complete a tax packet prior to arrival. Packets can be picked up Monday-Friday (8 a.m. – 5 p.m.) at the NHC Senior Resource Center.
- Make your appointment online at SRC.NHCgov.com or call 910-798-6416.

NHC Downtown Library, 3rd Floor: 201 Chestnut Street, Wilmington

- Days of operation:
 - Monday-Friday (10 a.m.-1 p.m.): In-person tax preparation by appointment only.
- Clients are required to complete a tax packet prior to arrival. Packets can be picked up at the NHC Main Library reference desk during open hours.
- To register for an appointment at this location, call 910-798-7341.

Please note, this year the Community Center in the Town of Carolina Beach will not be used as a VITA site as it undergoes renovations.

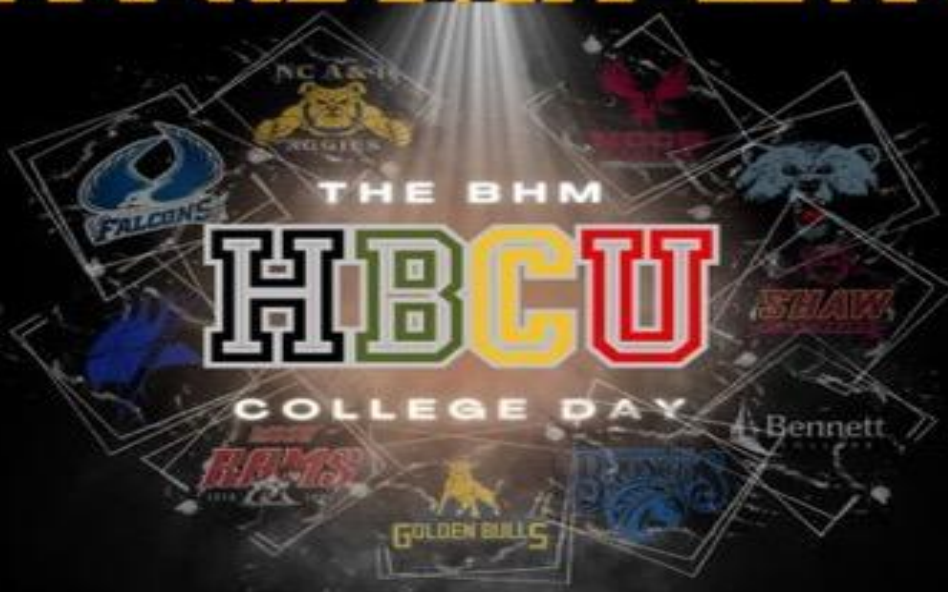

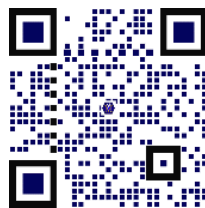
