





Topic of the Month—Tabernacle, Sacrifices, and Atonement

Unit I explores texts from Exodus and Leviticus that describe the system of sacrifices and offerings that created a holy people and place for the presence of the Lord.

Exodus 19:1-14 March 2—A Kingdom of Priests, A Holy Nation

People know that relationships come with responsibilities. How can we best honor our relationships? Yahweh calls the people a "treasured possession," a kingdom of priests, and a holy nation.

March 9—A Space for God

People treasure mountaintop experiences. How can we keep the power of such experiences fresh? Yahweh gives instructions for building a holy tent, a mobile Mount Sinai, that conveys Yahweh's intention to dwell with the covenant people.

March 16—The Ordination of Priests

Communities set apart certain persons to carry out special duties on behalf of the group. What are some ways of marking this special status? Exodus 29 describes Yahweh's instructions to Moses for the preparation of Aaron and his sons to the holy priesthood.

March 23—Offering a Sweet Aroma to God

People know that their relationships with others require effort. How can we maintain our relationships? In Leviticus, God's people are instructed to offer burnt sacrifices to maintain and restore their relationship with the LORD.

March 30—The Day of Atonement

People seek reconciliation when relationships have soured. What can we do to heal broken trust? Yahweh establishes an annual Day of Atonement that symbolizes for Israel the substitutionary atonement God provided for their sins and the total removal of their guilt.



NHC Fellows Program to offer financial assistance for students in mental health and substance use fields

WILMINGTON, N.C. (WECT) - Grad students at New Hanover County colleges can apply to the county's Fellows Program for financial assistance. The program offers forgivable financial assistance to anyone pursuing a career and will serve locally after graduating, according to the NHC Fellows Program.

The program has now received \$50 million in funds to increase more professionals in mental health and substance use disorder service providers.

"Over the last two years, we've connected with students who have a service-focused mentality and an incredible passion for this line of work—which is why we are so excited to begin working with our next cohort," said Chief Diversity and Equity Officer Linda Thompson. "We're grateful to our in-state institutions for their help in making this program possible, and we're excited to continue this partnership, which gets students the financial support they need for their educational journey while addressing a need for mental health providers in New Hanover County."

Anyone selected for the program who is enrolled in a psychiatric nurse practitioner program can receive up to \$4,500 per semester, with a maximum award of \$36,000. Students in the mental health provider program can receive \$3,500 per semester, with a maximum of \$14,000.

Applicants must be enrolled and in good standing with a North Carolina-accredited program to be eligible. Psychiatric nurse practitioners also must serve a minimum of three years in New Hanover County after graduating and obtaining a license, while mental health providers must serve two years.

This program offers young men and women the opportunity to learn about, and participate in, the legislative process of our state. It is a four-day long experience that allows high school students that are currently in grades ten, eleven, or twelve to observe firsthand how our laws are made. It provides them the unique privilege of working in the House Chamber in the midst of legislative action.

House Pages are important to the operation of the General Assembly as they assist the Members and staff of the House during the legislative session. They participate in daily sessions, committee meetings, and perform other duties including, but not limited to, delivering messages and materials within the legislative complex, completing mailings for Members, and passing out documents or running errands in the House Chamber during daily sessions.

Selection Process

The selection process for this program is highly competitive. Official appointments are made by the Speaker of the House based on recommendations by individual Representatives. Students submit their application to their Representative who selects the individuals to be appointed by the Speaker. Appointments are made on a first-come, first-served basis.

"Lenten Bible Reading Plan"


The book of Mark is attributed to John Mark, who wrote this letter to the church in Rome. It emphasizes the cross, Christian discipleship, the teachings of Jesus, and the importance of Jesus being not only man but also the Son of God. The gospel of Mark is simple and easy to understand. It walks through much of Jesus' earthly ministry as well as His death and resurrection. While being simple, it is also powerful and cultivates a deeper faith as we grow in our understanding of the life-changing, personal sacrifice that Jesus made for our sins. This makes the book of Mark a fantastic gospel to use as a Bible reading plan for the season of Lent. The Lenten season is March 5 – April 17.


