Topic of the Month—Christ's All-Sufficient Sacrifice

Unit Il turns to New Testament texts to explore the significance of Jesus's perfect sacrifice. In **lesson 6**, the Hebrew writers contrast the annual sacrifices required under the old system—a mere shadow of what was to come—with Jesus's once-for-all sacrifice. **Lesson 7** is drawn from 1 John 2, where John the Elder reminds us that the atoning sacrifice of Jesus is a demonstration of God's love. **Lesson 8** is the Easter lesson, which examines the details of Christ's death and resurrection. In **lesson 9**, the curtain opens on the throne room of heaven itself as the glorious lamb "that was slaughtered" is declared to be "worthy"!

April 6—Christ's All-Sufficient Sacrifice

Hebrews 9:23-28

People base their day-to-day lives on what has worked in the past. What if they were to learn that what worked in the past really didn't work?

Compared to the effect of Christ's single sacrifice for sin, the repeated rituals of the Torah are found wanting. Christ's life and death seal God's covenant with us, put God's law into our hearts and minds, and guide us to live faithfully.

April 13—Christ the Atoning Sacrifice

1 John 2:1-6

False news breeds hostility and leads people to believe in lies. How can we know the truth? The truth of Christ's atoning sacrifice, as an expression of God's love, demonstrates itself in love among believers and for the world.

April 20—Christ Dies and Rises to New Life

Matthew 27:39-40; 45-54

People want their lives to have meaning. What meaning can we find? Matthew tells us that Jesus's death and resurrection find meaning in the Temple and the OT sacrificial teachings, leading to worship of the Risen One.

April 27—The Lamb Is Worthy

Revelation 5:1-10

People make sacrifices for those they love. What sacrifices are to be lifted up for their lasting value? In Revelation, Christ, the "slaughtered lamb" sacrificed for the sin of the world, is lifted to the throne of God and is worthy of praise and honor forever.






Darius earned his Culinary Arts degree from CFCC in 2016, and his family aims to provide financial assistance to students in this program.





NHC Fellows Program to offer financial assistance for students in mental health and substance use fields

WILMINGTON, N.C. (WECT) - Grad students at New Hanover County colleges can apply to the county's Fellows Program for financial assistance. The program offers forgivable financial assistance to anyone pursuing a career and will serve locally after graduating, according to the NHC Fellows Program.

The program has now received \$50 million in funds to increase more professionals in mental health and substance use disorder service providers.

"Over the last two years, we've connected with students who have a service-focused mentality and an incredible passion for this line of work—which is why we are so excited to begin working with our next cohort," said Chief Diversity and Equity Officer Linda Thompson. "We're grateful to our in-state institutions for their help in making this program possible, and we're excited to continue this partnership, which gets students the financial support they need for their educational journey while addressing a need for mental health providers in New Hanover County."

Anyone selected for the program who is enrolled in a psychiatric nurse practitioner program can receive up to \$4,500 per semester, with a maximum award of \$36,000. Students in the mental health provider program can receive \$3,500 per semester, with a maximum of \$14,000.

Applicants must be enrolled and in good standing with a North Carolina-accredited program to be eligible. Psychiatric nurse practitioners also must serve a minimum of three years in New Hanover County after graduating and obtaining a license, while mental health providers must serve two years.

Applications are open until June 30.




