I'm Tired of "Out of Order" Funerals!

After 31 years of pastoring, I have seen some "out of order" stuff happen at funerals. I'm writing to help bring some order and honor back to funerals and final celebrations. This is not directed to any family, here it is!

- 1. It is out of order to set a funeral date or time before confirming the availability of the pastor or the church first.
- 2. It is out of order to use "Go Fund Me" to pay for your funeral. This is embarrassing and a long shot. Please get life insurance or put away about \$10,000 to pay for your own final rites.
- 3. If the deceased had a pastor, it is the pastors call on whether he or she will preach the funeral at that church. If the family desires someone else, a conversation should be held with the pastor first before the other choice of person is even contacted. In most cases, the request of the family can be honored.
- 4. It is out of order to wear "Tupac", or Big Papa" shirts with cursing and skulls on it at the funeral of a faithful believer. Black, white, or gray is always appropriate for funerals. Preferably a dressy look to honor the deceased. If you are on program, please dress modestly. Ministers should avoid eccentric dress at any time for a funeral.
- 5. It is out of order to take longer than 2-3 minutes to speak, unless more time is given by the pastor or family. You can't tell all so do your 2 to 3 minutes and sit down.
- 6. It is out of order to let any and everybody speak at your funeral. You do not want anybody who desires to speak to speak. Trust me on that. This can get wild and embarrassing! There shouldn't be any more than 2 or 3 people for this segment of the funeral, and it's helpful to list their names.
- 7. It is out of order to read every telegram sent to the family. Please announcer select 3 letters and put the others in a nice album for the family to read at a later time. 40 letters should not be read!
- 8. It is out of order to be high or intoxicated at a funeral where honor is being bestowed to God and the deceased. I have seen both
- 9. A love gift for the church, the pastor, and the musician is always appreciated! Consider leaving a scholarship in your name, a sizable gift for development, or a major donation to your church family. We leave sustaining gifts for the Zoo and other places, and nothing for the ministry that helped us get to heaven. Just a thought!

Funerals should never be planned without the careful advisement of a pastor, church leader, or funeral director.



Topic of the Month—The Genesis of Altars and Sacrifices: Unit I shows that building altars and making sacrifices predates the Mosaic law. Lesson 1 looks at the first known offerings to God in the Bible, those given by Cain and Abel in Genesis 4. Lesson 2 follows Noah. As the floodwaters subside, he stepped onto dry land, built an altar, and offered burnt offerings to God. In lesson 3, Genesis 22 relates Abraham's most significant test of faith—the willingness to sacrifice his only son, Isaac, to God. Lesson 4 fast forwards in time to Isaac as a mature man of faith who builds his own altar and calls on the name of the Lord. In lesson 5, the texts from Genesis 28, 33, and 35 are examined as Jacob leads the next generation in faith and builds altars to worship Yahweh.

June 1—Cain and Abel Offer Sacrifices

Giving gifts to show appreciation and honor is a common practice. How do we expect our gifts to be received? From their very livelihood, Cain and Abel offer gifts to God, but Cain grew angry because Abel's gift was more pleasing to God.

June 8-Noah Builds an Altar

When people come through harrowing events, they feel grateful. How do people express these feelings? After the Great Flood, Noah built an altar on dry land and offered burnt offerings that so pleased the Lord that God promised never again to destroy the earth with a flood.

June 15—Abraham Makes an Offering

Obedience and trust are marks of commitment to one another. What do we offer to demonstrate ultimate allegiance and commitment? Abraham passes the test of faithfulness to God in his willingness to sacrifice his own son, Isaac, on the altar.

June 22—Isaac Calls on the Name of the Lord


As children grow to adulthood, they step into their own lives. What do we take with us from our family of origin? Isaac receives the blessing and promises that God made to his father, Abraham. In response, Isaac builds an altar and calls on the name of the Lord.


June 29—Jacob Sets Up a Sacred Pillar

Meaningful events and places can hold a lasting impression. How do we mark important events in life? Jacob marks his important encounters with altars, offerings, and signs of worship.


