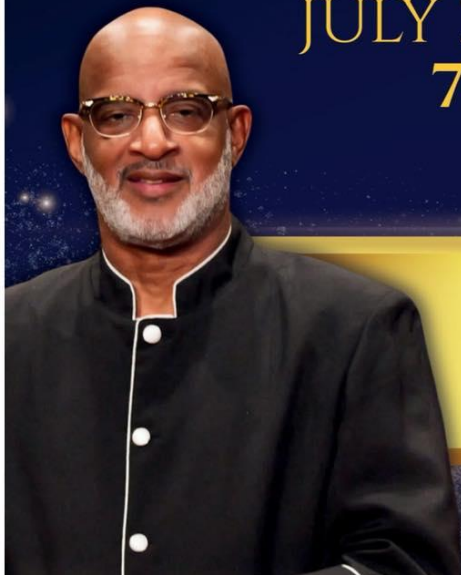

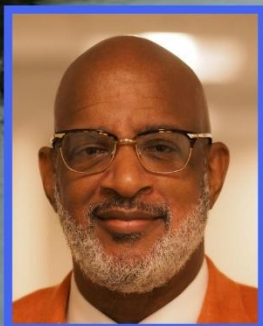

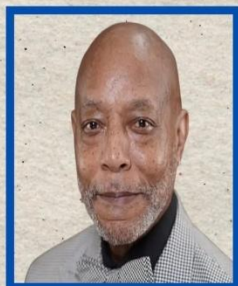

## **Topic of the Month—Jesus and the Temple**

Unit II explores texts from the Gospels that depict Jesus's relation to the Temple.

**Lesson 6** recounts the event from Jesus's youth, when at age twelve he amazed the teachers at the Temple with his keen insights. **Lesson 7** draws from Matthew 12, in which Jesus and his disciples are criticized for violating the Sabbath. Jesus declares himself Lord of the Sabbath and greater than the Temple.

**Lesson 8** explores John's account of Jesus's cleansing the Temple. In the discussion that followed, Jesus declared himself able to raise "this temple" in three days. "This temple," in Jesus's use here, was his own body. **Lesson 9**, from Matthew 23 and 24, records Jesus's shocking prediction that the magnificent Temple would one day be destroyed.

### **July 6—The Boy Jesus in the Temple**

Some children are wise beyond their years. How do we respond when we encounter such wisdom? At the age of twelve, Jesus already understands more about his relationship to the Temple than his parents can comprehend, and they are astonished by his wisdom.

### **July 13—Lord of the Sabbath**

People legitimize the authority of institutions. When is it appropriate to question this authority? During the discourse of plucking grain on the Sabbath, Jesus declares that his authority supersedes that of the Temple.

### **July 20—Cleansing the Temple**

People sometimes lack awareness of building protocols and may enter a space with little regard for the business that transpires there. What does it mean to honor a building and the purpose for which it was constructed? Jesus shows proper reverence for the Temple when he zealously clears out the merchants.

### **July 27—Jesus Predicts the Temple's Destruction**

Grand structures appear to be indestructible. What might cause even the sturdiest buildings to deteriorate? Jesus warns that the magnificent Temple will be destroyed as a sign of his coming and of the end of the age.

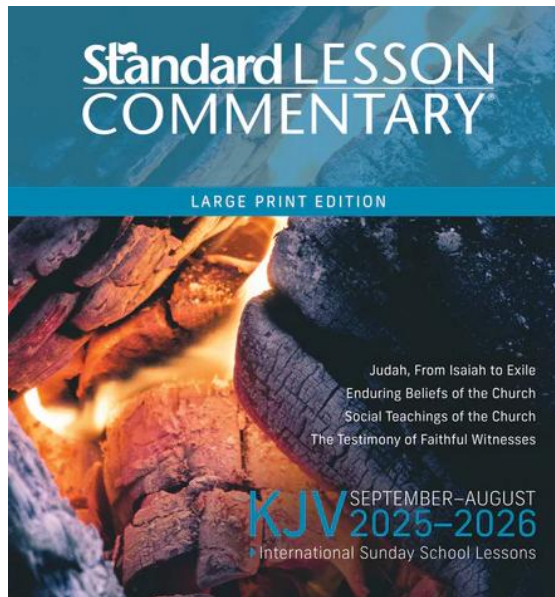
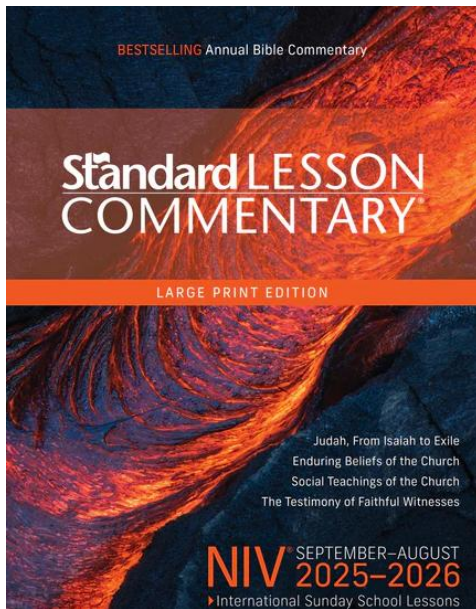
